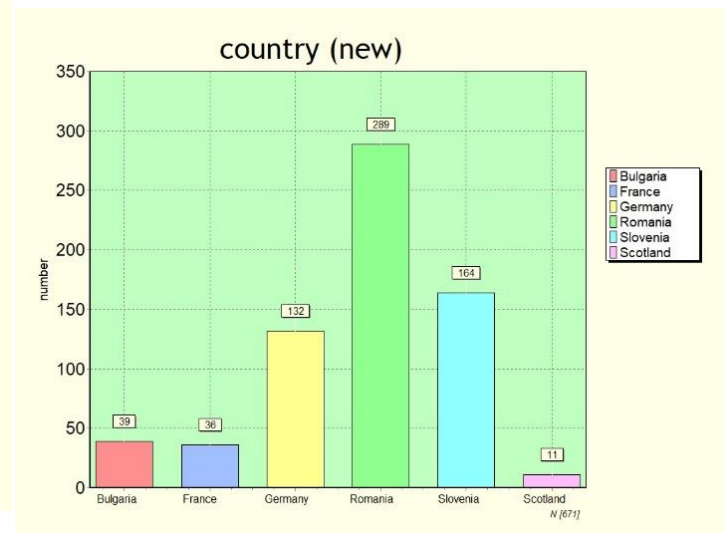
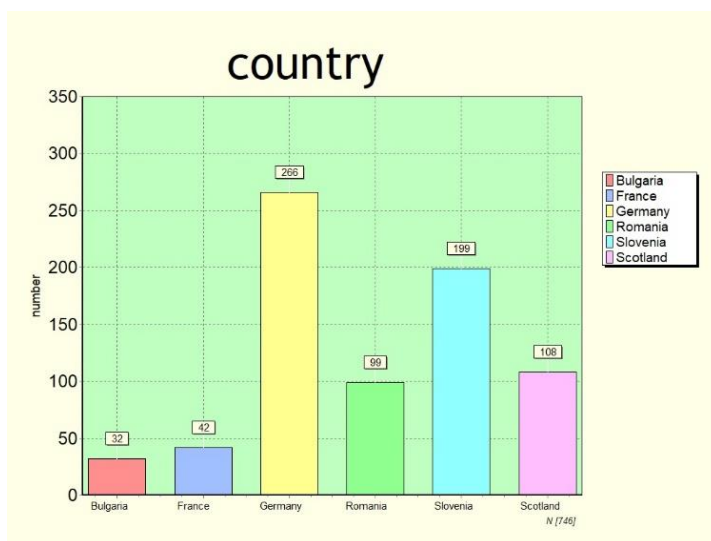


Evaluation of the Art Nouveau – Art Renouveau Questionnaire

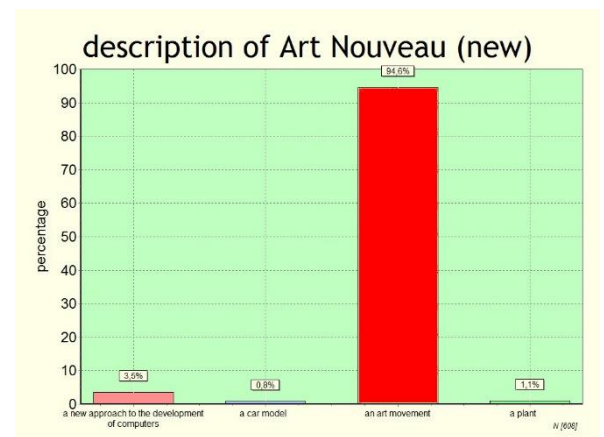

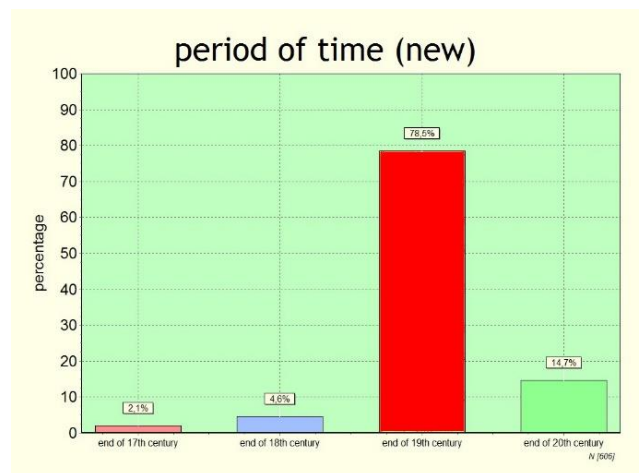
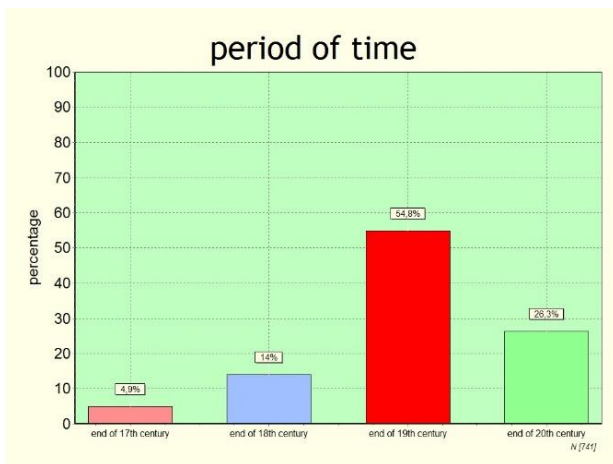
Especially So the meaning of the survey is limited, still some conclusions on the impact of the project can be drawn.

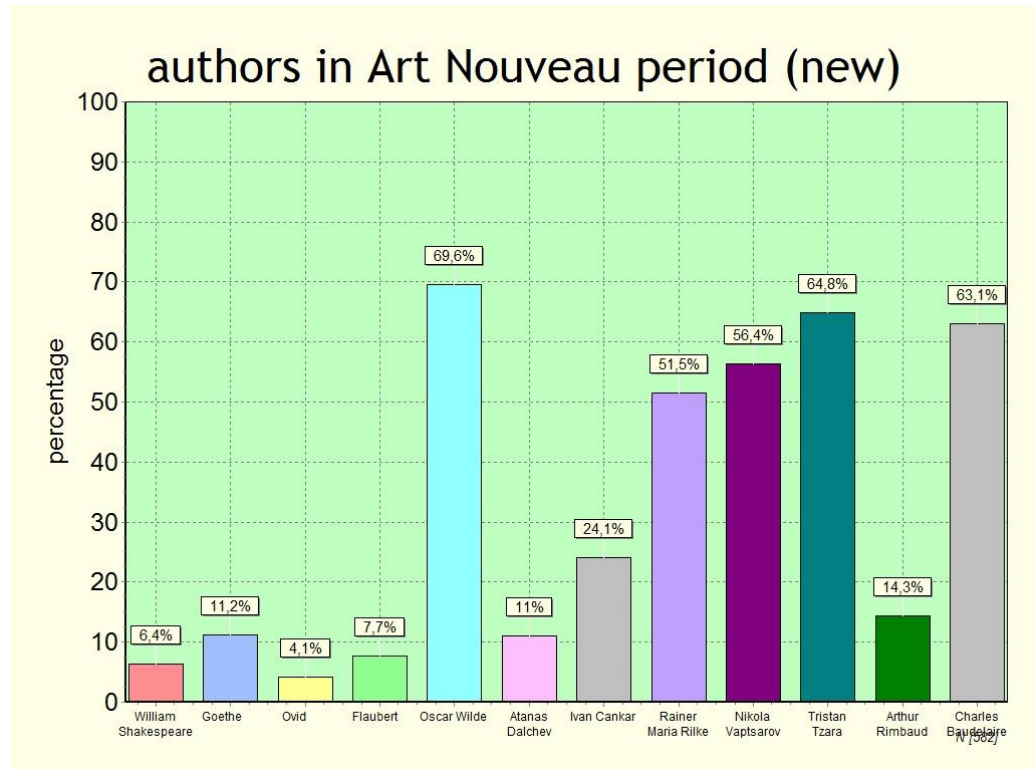
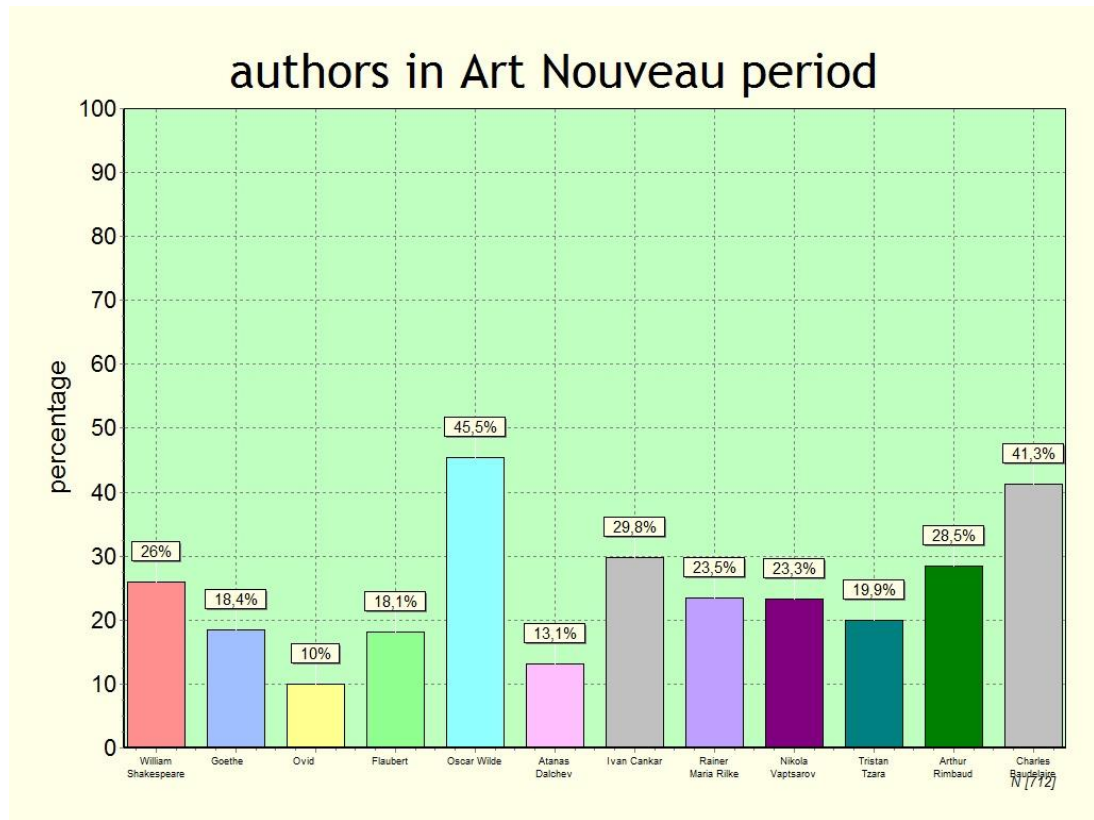
The improvement here is not surprising as, with the exception of Vienna) are all places we have visited during our mobilities.

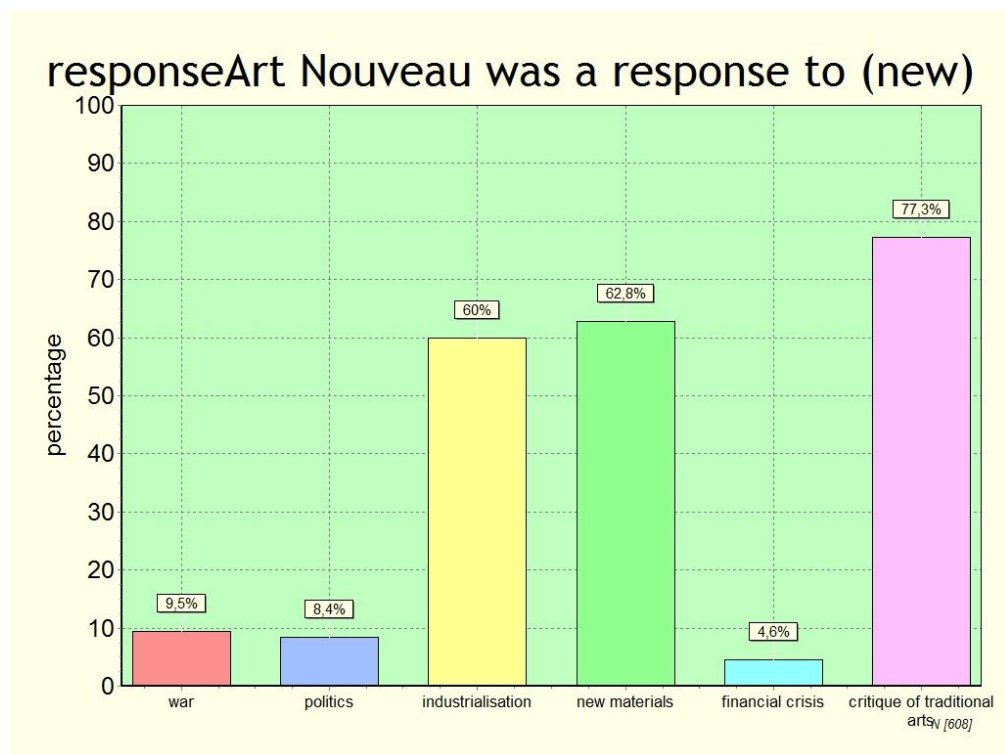
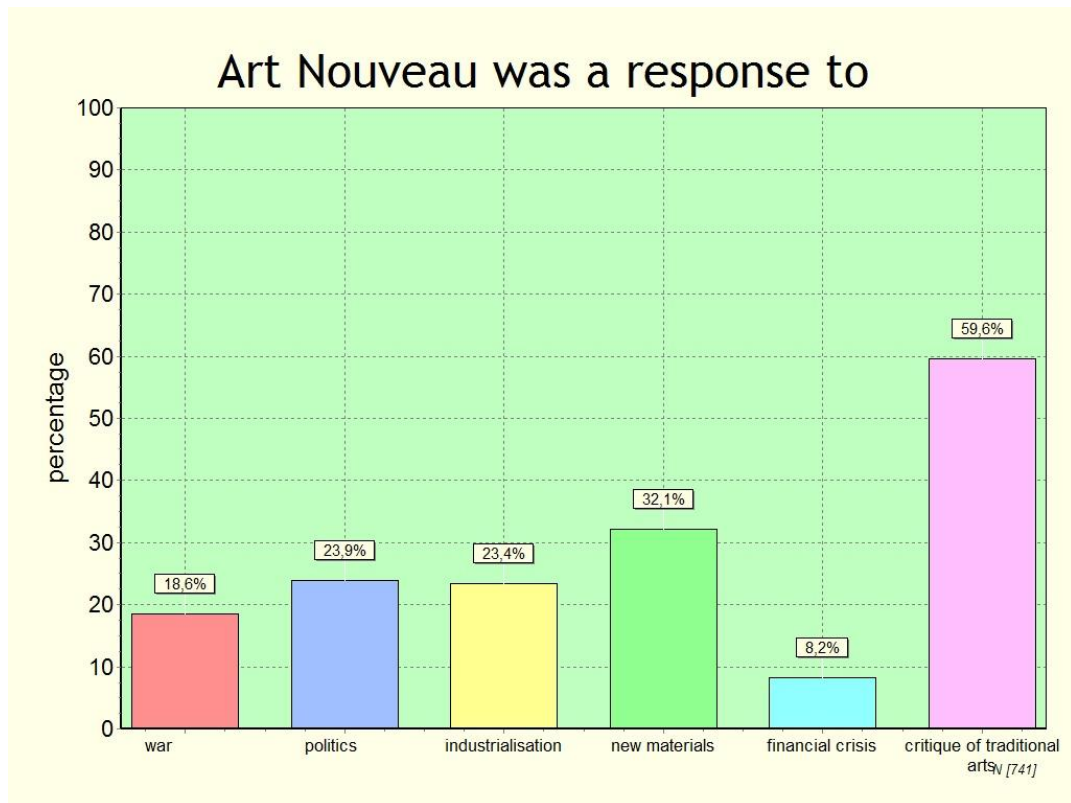
